## How All Area Teams and MVJ are Calculated

Each student performance for the contest is pulled off judgingcard. Their placing and the total number that judged in the contest are recorded and then converted to a percentage. The percentages are averaged together.
Here is an example:

Joe Smith

| 1 st of 65 at Bexar Invitational Fall CDE's | $=1.5 \%$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| 5 th of 42 at Hondo Invitational Fall CDE AM Contest | $=11.9 \%$ |
| 18 th of 73 at Hill Invitational Fall CDE | $=24.7 \%$ |
| AVERAGE SCORE | $=12.7 \%$ |

The student with the lowest percent is the Most Valuable Judger.
The next four lowest numbers will make up the All Area Team.
No school can have more than two on the team.
A teacher may nominate up to two.
Only members of a team who competed in the qualifying division can be nominated.
The committee voted that only students who participate in $50 \%$ or more of the contests recorded are eligible for the honors.
