Students,

We are very excited that you are interested in expanding your leadership skills by attending the 2023 Area 7 Leadership Camp! This camp is designed to provide you opportunities to further develop your leadership skills so that you are a better leader for your FFA chapter and/or district. ALC is also a great place to make connections that can last a lifetime! By the time you arrive at ALC the Area 7 Officers will have poured many hours into preparing every little detail to make this a great experience for you. So, in addition to the items listed below, be sure to bring a great attitude and an open mind to allow you to get the most out of ALC!

We are excited to experience our first ALC on the campus of Schreiner University! You will be staying in Baldwin Hall, the newest residence hall on campus! You will be issued a dorm room key at check-in and will be expected to keep up with your key for the duration of ALC. **A fee of \$100 per lost dorm key will be charged to your chapter.**

What to Bring to Camp!

- Clothing/Attire
 - Clothes must be school appropriate.
 - **Acceptable Attire:** jeans/long pants, shorts at least thumb length, tops must have straps that are at least three fingers in width; shirts and tops must cover the midriff at all times with no skin exposed;
 - **Unacceptable Attire:** cropped shirts, off the shoulder wear, strapless, spaghetti straps, muscle shirts, and low cut attire are not permitted; the advertising of, or emblems of, alcoholic beverages, drugs, tobacco products, profanity, or emblems of seductive or sexually insinuating nature are considered in poor taste and will not be worn or displayed
 - Special attire will be needed for:
 - Ag Olympics – Bring clothing you don't mind getting dirty and/or wet.
 - Dance – You can dress to the camp theme, but attire must still meet the “appropriate attire” description.
- Closed-toe Shoes - No sandals!
- Bedding (XL Twin Sheets or Sleeping Bag, Pillow, Blanket)
- Bath Towels and Washcloth
- Toiletries (Bath Soap, Hand soap, Shampoo, Shower Shoes, Toothbrush, & Toothpaste, etc.)
- Sunscreen/Bug Spray/Hat
- Flashlight
- Suitcase/duffle bag - Please limit the amount of bags as you will be sharing a room with another camper.
- Water Bottle - Please bring a refillable water bottle with you that you can fill up with water to stay hydrated in between meals.

Electronic devices - You will be asked to leave your phone, and other electronic devices, in your dorm during the day at camp. You may use them when we turn in for the night. In case of an emergency your FFA Advisor has a phone number to contact and FFA Advisors chaperoning the camp will have phone access.

Should you have any questions about ALC prior to arrival, please ask your FFA Advisor. If they don't have the answers, they are able to contact me for the information. Also, please remember that all students attending ALC must be dropped off and picked up by their Ag Teacher, unless prior arrangements have been communicated with me for another adult to drop you off or pick you up. No students are allowed to drive themselves, or anyone else, to ALC.
